## PULASKI COUNTY RECREATION VOLUNTEER CODE OF ETHICS AND RULES

- 1. Volunteers will portray a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of respect, loyalty, patience, courtesy, tact and maturity.
- 2. Smoking or use of tobacco products in the presence of children is prohibited.
- 3. Using, possessing, or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
- 4. Volunteers shall not abuse children including:
  - Physical Abuse-strike, spank, shake, or slap
  - Verbal Abuse-humiliate, degrade, threaten
  - Sexual Abuse-including inappropriate touching and exposure
  - Mental Abuse
- 5. Volunteers must treat children of all races, religions, and cultures with respect and consideration.
- 6. Volunteers shall abstain from humiliating or frightening discipline techniques.
- 7. Volunteers shall not use profanity in the presence of children or parents.
- 8. Volunteers will refrain from intimate display of affection toward others in the presence of children, parents and staff.
- 9. Volunteers must be free of physical and psychological conditions that might adversely affect children's health, including fever or contagious conditions.
- 10. Volunteers will do everything in their power to avoid being in a situation where they are alone with a child other than their own.

I understand that any violation of this code may be grounds for removal as a volunteer.
